1. Introduction

Mahagenco Renewable Energy Limited (A fully owned subsidiary of MAHAGENCO) intends to develop Renewable Energy Power Projects in Maharashtra, for which the land will be acquired anywhere in Maharashtra. Hence proposals are invited from the reputed law firms for due diligence of land acquired for setting up Renewable Energy Projects.

2. Intent of The Expression Of Interest (EoI)

The objective of this Expression of Interest (EOI) is to identify, evaluate, and empanel reputed and experienced law firms that can provide comprehensive legal support for land due diligence in relation to renewable energy projects across Maharashtra State.

Given that land acquisition, title verification, and compliance with applicable laws are critical prerequisites for successful project development, the empanelment aims to create a panel of law firms capable of delivering timely, accurate, and legally robust opinions on land-related matters.

The selected law firms will be expected to undertake:

- Examination of land title deeds and chain of ownership.
- Verification of encumbrances, litigations, and charges.
- Review of revenue records, government notifications, and local regulations.
- Assessment of land use permissions, conversion, zoning, and statutory approvals.
- Identification of legal risks and liabilities affecting land acquisition/lease.
- Providing clear legal opinions and reports to support decision-making for renewable energy project development.

The empanelment will ensure availability of specialized legal expertise on a need basis, across different geographies, thereby facilitating smooth and legally compliant land acquisition and development of renewable energy projects.

Assignment of work will be on a case-to-case basis at the discretion of MREL.

4. Scope of work.

Scope of Work for Legal Vetting of Land Documents & Records of required land for proposed Renewable Energy projects (Solar / wind/ Hybrid/PSP projects) in Maharashtra

- a. **General Scope** To review/examine/conduct due diligence of project site title deeds/ property documents, revenue records from offices of various Revenue Authorities, Sub-Registrar, Registrar of Companies, etc. To certify valid & absolute title and to ensure that the property(ies) is/are free from all encumbrances and Litigations. If required, seek assistance from any local counsel/advocate for this purpose (land title search report). However, the Legal title opinion/ Legal title search report should be submitted only which should be based upon its own independent verification of the title documents including mutation records, ECs/Jamabandis etc. as the case may be.
- b. **Documents Review** Review of revenue records (such as 7/12 extracts, mutation entries, form 8A extracts), title deeds, court orders, revenue orders, allotment orders etc. which will be provided by the Project developer, to understand flow of title, identification of issues, and suggesting mitigates. The Land Documents review included but not limited to the following list
 - I. Old survey no. or 7/12
 - II. Old Mutation entries
 - III. Manual/Digital 7/12 of 30 years
 - IV. Mutation entries
 - v. BA Certificate (Record of land) ownership along with 7/12
 - vi. Village Form no. 1C certificate
 - VII. Village Form no. 6C certificate
 - viii. Gat Map
 - IX. Visar Pavti, if any
 - x. Mortgage NOC
 - xı. Village Map
 - XII. Zone Certificate

- c. **Independent Searches** Conducting desktop searches in the offices of the jurisdictional sub registrars, courts, and quasi-judicial authorities to identify impediments in the title of the land.
- d. **Restrictive Categories of Lands** Restricted categories of lands such as class 2 lands, inam and watan lands are identified during the diligence process to determine prior approvals that may be require for the acquisition.
- e. **Diligence Period** Generally prior period of 30 years for the land underlying the project (to be acquired on sale/lease basis) and 13 years for land underlying the access roads and transmission assets (to be acquired under right of way and easement agreements).
- f. To provide Govt. ready reckoner rate for the last three years for the land under purview.
- g. To assist in the preparation and vetting of lease deed drafts for individual land parcels being acquired/taken on lease. The law firm will ensure that the lease agreements are legally sound, compliant with applicable laws and regulations, and protect the company's rights in relation to the use and possession of the said lands.

5. Evaluation of EOI

The outcome of Expression of Interest, evaluated on the basis of eligibility criteria given above, MREL will select the law firm. 5 No. of firms will be selected on the basis of evaluation.
