For Lifting and transportation of Dry Fly Ash  
by rail/ road mode from Koradi and  
Khaperkheda TPS.

### **Preamble:**

Maharashtra State Power Generation Company Limited herein referred to as Mahagenco has the highest overall power generation capacity and the highest thermal installed capacity amongst all the state power-generating utilities of India.

In line with the directives from MoEF & CC and the Ash Utilization Policy – 2025, to enhance the dry fly ash utilisation at Mahagenco's Koradi and Khaperkheda thermal power stations, Mahagenco is exploring various innovative ways. As a part of this, Mahagenco is exploring the possibility wherein genuine bulk dry fly ash users shall lift and transport dry fly ash generated at Koradi and Khaperkheda TPS by rail/ road mode by developing railway infrastructure and efficient evacuation systems.

### **Qualifying Requirement:**

1. Average annual financial turnover during the last 3 years, ending 31st March of the previous financial year should be **Rs. 500Cr.**
2. The bidder should have experience in utilizing a minimum of **25 lakh MT** of ash from each of at least two different thermal power plants in the previous financial year.
3. The bidder should have experience of loading minimum **365 ash rakes** each year in the last 3 financial years.
4. The bidder must own a minimum of 100 bulkers and 100 tippers.
5. The bidder should have adequate customer base like ready mix concrete plants, AAC block plants or cement plants.
6. The bidder who is in litigation with Mahagenco or its subsidiaries will not be eligible to participate in this EOI.
7. JV/consortium not allowed.

### **General terms and conditions**

1. The bidder should have Income Tax Permanent Account Number (PAN) and valid GST Registration.
2. The bidder should have valid certificate of incorporation as proprietary firm / partnership / company as per Company Act from appropriate authorities.
3. The bidder shall not have been blacklisted, banned, or debarred by any Government, Semi-Government, PSU's or any other organization at the time of submission of the EOI. The bidder shall submit an Affidavit for Bidders Past Record) duly signed by the Authorized Signatory of the firm.

4. Submit relevant documents duly attested by the authorized signatory in support of the eligibility criteria.
5. Undertaking and commitments from bidder to prevent Conflict of Interest duly signed by the Authorized Signatory of the firm
6. The bidders are required to submit documentary evidence in support of qualifying criteria. The applicants meeting the above criteria shall only be considered for evaluation.

**Scope of Mahagenco:**

1. Mahagenco will permit the agency for loading of dry fly ash from Koradi and Khaperkheda TPS inside plant area. Mahagenco disclaims in regards to the quality of dry fly ash & dry fly ash will be made available on as is where is basis.
2. Mahagenco will give Co-user permission to the agency only for transportation of dry fly ash by rail from thermal power plants so that it will be convenient for the agency to make indent for rakes and pay the freight & other statutory charges to Railways directly.
3. In case of non-availability of dry fly ash due to reason beyond control of Mahagenco or forced / planned outages of Power Plant etc., same shall be communicated to the agency. Further restart schedule of ash loading / transportation shall jointly be worked out between Power Station & the agency.
4. Mahagenco shall provide suitable loading point near silo for filling of ash in bulkers / closed body vehicles etc. for road mode transportation.
5. Mahagenco cooperation is subject to existing infrastructure & facilities as on date.
6. Suitable Land (if available) shall be provided for development of infrastructure. Ownership of land shall be strictly retained by Mahagenco throughout contract period.

**Scope of the agency:**

• **Rail Mode:**

1. Successful bidder shall have to install the rail loading system with silos on existing rail line and near the existing platform location. If required the bidder shall modify the concerned railway line & existing rail loading infrastructure at its own cost.

2. Successful bidder shall have to Install/routing of pneumatic conveying system from the ESP to new rail loading system.
3. The agency shall arrange required number of rakes.
4. O&M of rail loading system
5. Railway freight, demurrage, tarpaulin covering and wharfage shall be in bidder's scope.
6. All Statutory approvals and compliance required for the rake movement.
7. End user certification and MoEFCC compliance.
8. The agency shall deploy manpower at respective Railway Division Office, loading & unloading stations for smooth movement of rakes, coordination with railways for its entire movement for faster turnaround of rakes.
9. The agency will inform Mahagenco in advance before placement of rake for loading.

- **Road Mode**

1. The agency shall arrange required number of bulkers, closed body type vehicle etc. on its own for road mode transportation for dry fly ash.
2. The agency shall deploy manpower at respective TPS for loading of ash in the bulkers, closed body type vehicle etc. on its own.
3. All Statutory approvals and compliance required for bulkers or closed body type vehicles etc. road movement.
4. The agency shall ensure ash loading in bulkers or closed body type vehicles etc. shall be done within RTO permissible capacity limit.

- **General Scope of Agency**

1. The Agencies may visit the site for having complete idea of existing infrastructure and available facilities for loading of dry fly ash in Rail wagons.
2. The agency will abide and solely responsible for all the rules and regulations for labour and wages, safety as per statutory requirement.
3. The agency will lift dry fly ash on regular 24 hrs. basis subject to availability of dry fly ash in the silos.
4. The agency shall be responsible for any situation arising due to spillage of dry fly ash during transportation.

**Financial Assistance:**

- Bidder has to quote lowest financial assistance in Rs. /MT.
- The financial assistance shall be inclusive of all applicable taxes in force.
- The quoted financial assistance shall remain valid for a period of 180 (One Hundred Eighty) days from the date of opening of the financial assistance envelope.
- Payment of financial assistance shall be made annually after assessing exact quantity of ash lifted during the assessment year.

**Selection Criteria:**

- The bidder satisfying all the qualification criteria and quoting for lowest financial assistance will be shortlisted as L1 bidder.
- Incomplete EOIs or EOIs without required annexures/schedules/supporting documents will be summarily rejected.

**Quantity Available:**

- The approximate quantity of dry fly ash available for transportation by rail/ road mode is as follows:

TPS	Quantity (Lakh MT/year)
Koradi	20
Khaperkheda	10

- Actual generated quantity per year may vary and Mahagenco reserves right to change/modify the quantity on its own discretion.

**Contract Operating Authority:**

- The selected agency shall have to enter into separate agreements with Koradi and Khaperkheda TPS.
- Chief Engineer, Koradi TPS and Chief Engineer, Khaperkheda TPS will be Contract Operating Authority for respective TPS.

**Security Deposit (Performance Bank Guarantee):**

- The selected agency shall have to submit security deposit of 5% of contract value or Rs.5,00,00,000/- (Rs. Five Crore only) whichever is higher in the form of E-Bank Guarantee (E-BG) towards performance from a Nationalized Bank.
- Pro-forma for same will be provided by Mahagenco.

**Financial Assistance & Penalty:**

- Performance will be evaluated on yearly basis for payment of financial assistance and action as per below table shall be initiated.

- Further, the selected agency shall also be liable to bear the Environmental Compensation (EC) levied by regulatory authorities on Mahagenco for non-compliance with fly ash utilization norms.
- In the event of non-performance i.e. failure to lift the committed quantity of dry fly ash for consecutive 3 months or more as per the agreement, Mahagenco reserves the right to grant access to the installed infrastructure to other agencies of its own choice for the purpose of ensuring uninterrupted ash evacuation and 100% ash utilization as mandated under statutory compliance with MOEF notification and Ash Utilization Policy -2025.

**Period of Contract:**

- Bidder shall have to install and commission the railways infrastructure within 6 months from the date of signing of contract agreement.
- The contract period for this work will be 15 (Fifteen) years. Performance of the agency against contract is to be reviewed every 3 year. However, if there is a significant change in market conditions, such as increased demand for ash or improved commercial viability, Mahagenco reserves the right to review and revise the terms of financial assistance or other related conditions. Such revisions may include introduction of royalty, revenue-sharing mechanisms or modification in financial assistance. It shall be binding on the bidder.

**Taxes and Duties:**

The agency shall be liable and responsible for payment towards any taxes, duties, levies, GST etc. as applicable /enforced (By State/ Central Government) from time to time during the tenure of the contract. Such liabilities if any shall be paid by the agency extra at actual without having any financial implications to Mahagenco.

**Pollution Control and Transportation of Dry Fly Ash:**

- The agency has to follow all the rules and regulation given by CPCB and MPCB time to time for lifting and transportation of dry fly ash. All possible measures shall be taken by the agency to avoid pollution to the satisfaction of the plant officials. Similarly, while transporting, no spillage of dry fly ash would be permitted to avoid air pollution. If the process adopted by the agency is found deficient, Mahagenco holds the right to stop the supply of dry fly ash.
- Mahagenco is to be indemnified from any issue arising due to pollution caused during and after lifting & transportation of ash. Penalty due to pollution if any shall be paid to the concerned Authorities by the agency.
- In case of non-compliance with CPCB/MPCB norms by agency, Mahagenco shall have the right to recover applicable penalties, if any, imposed by statutory authorities, from agency and/or to suspend or terminate the dry fly ash supply without liability to Mahagenco.

**Safety:**

The agency would be responsible for the safety of its people for which the agency should provide necessary safety equipment to its workers. The agency shall be fully responsible for maintaining all the insurance covers as per law of land at its own cost.

**Working Hours:**

Delivery of dry fly ash is intended to be round clock on all days including Sundays and Holiday or as per the instructions of Engineer-in- charge.

**Force majeure:**

Force Majeure is herein defined as any cause which is beyond the control of Bidder or Mahagenco, as the case may be, which they could not foresee or with a reasonable amount of diligence could not have foreseen and which substantially affects the performance of the contract such as:

(a) Natural calamity including but not limited to floods, drought, earthquakes and epidemics.

(b) Acts of any government, domestic or foreign, including but not limited to war, declared or undeclared quarantines, embargoes etc. provided either party shall, within fifteen (15) days from the occurrence of such a cause, notify the other in writing of such causes. Unless otherwise directed by MSPGCL in writing Bidder shall continue to perform his obligation under the contract as far as reasonably

practical and shall seek all the alternative means for work otherwise mutually agreed by both the parties in writing, both parties continue to perform their performance not pre- vented by the force Majeure event.

Unless obligation under this EOI/agreement as far as reasonably practical and shall seek alternative means for performance not prevented by the force Majeure event.

Bidder as well as MSPGCL shall not be liable for delays in performing their respective obligations under this EOI/agreement resulting from any force Majeure cause as referred to and / or defined above. The date of completion for fulfillment of the said obligation affected by the force Majeure events shall be extended by a reasonable time period to be mutually agreed upon between the parties.

**Other Important Conditions:**

1. Lifting of dry fly ash to be done through rail mode subject to existing infrastructure.
2. The agency shall develop rail loading infrastructure.
3. The agency would be entirely responsible towards RTO/Railways for overloading of dry fly ash, Mahagenco in any case will not be held responsible for the same.
4. Loading completion time of filling ash into wagons varies depending upon the availability of ash in silos, system readiness etc. Hence, Mahagenco is not responsible for any demurrage for the railway rake deployed.
5. **Mahagenco reserves the rights to supply the quantity not lifted by the agency to any other party at the sole discretion of Mahagenco.**
6. The agency should depute its authorized representative at the respective TPS for co-ordination and taking delivery of dry fly ash.
7. The agency will be responsible for any kind of injuries or accidents caused to their employees, labors, any other person or object and Mahagenco will not be held responsible in the matter. The agency shall indemnify Mahagenco if any such incident occurs.
8. The agency shall have valid license, permissions etc. of Statutory, State /Central Govt. Authority for transportation of dry fly ash for both rail/road mode as applicable.
9. The interested agencies are requested to visit the site before submitting the EOI. If the representatives of the agency want to visit the site, they have to give prior intimation to this office on the mail id provided or on the mobile number of the contact person mentioned herein so as to arrange the security

passes and local site visit.

**The agency/organizations fulfilling the qualifying requirements shall submit the EOI on or before 02.03.2026, 15.00 Hrs.**

- The Expression of Interest received from the interested agencies will be scrutinized in line with the qualifying requirements and shall be submitted for the approval of Competent Authority.
- The interested agency shall furnish the necessary documents (Original/Attested copies of documents duly signed by Authorized signatory to be attached with the application) in support for fulfilment of the qualifying criteria and other requirements, if asked for verification during scrutiny and/or even after completion of the process.
- The interested agency shall furnish work completion certificates from the concerned department in support of fulfilment of the qualifying criteria. The authority not below the rank of Executive Engineer or equivalent of the concerned Department shall issue the work completion certificate.
- The interested agency should attach attested copies of valid certificate of incorporation as proprietary firm / partnership / company from appropriate Authority.
- The interested agency shall be short-listed based on their experience and credential submitted by them in line with Qualifying Requirements.
- EOI documents will neither be issued manually nor be sent by post or courier. Blank EOI documents can be viewed and downloaded free of cost by intending firms online on website <https://www.mahagenco.in> .
- Mahagenco may modify /amend the EOI conditions, extend the due date of submission, change the selection process, reject any or all application without assigning any reasons thereof.
- Any amendment/modification of the EOI document shall be posted only in the website of MAHAGENCO <https://www.mahagenco.in>.

- **Vendor Registration:**

- xxi. EOIs in which both technical documents and financial assistance quotation are submitted in a single envelope will be considered as non-responsive and shall be summarily rejected.
- xxii. EOI applications received after the deadline will not be considered for further process of EOI.

2. All the interested agencies shall specifically note that the Mahagenco may demand to see the originals of the above stated certificates for verification and if the interested agencies does not produce the original certificates within 7 days of receipt of such demand, their EOI application may be liable to be rejected as non- responsive.

3. If it is established at any later date that the any agency has furnished false information / documents, the agency shall become liable for action, which may include, termination of contract, valid legal action and black listing.

4. Mahagenco reserves the full rights to reject any or all EOI offer without assigning any reason whatsoever.

- **Other general conditions for selection:**

- i. Mahagenco shall scrutinize the documents submitted by the agencies based on the qualification criteria specified in EoI.
- ii. The agency shall be short-listed based on their experience and credential submitted by them in line with Qualifying Requirements.
- iii. Only technically qualified bidders will be considered for opening of the Financial Assistance Envelope.
- iv. Canvassing in any form is strictly prohibited and any agency found to have resorted to canvassing shall be liable to have his application rejected summarily.

- v. In the event of the application submitted by a partnership firm, an authorized partner must sign it or in the event of absence of any partner, it must be signed by a person holding a power of attorney authorizing him to do so, such power of attorney should be produced along with the application.
- vi. Mahagenco reserves all the rights to reject any or all the application received, without assigning any reason thereof, whatsoever it may be.
- vii. The courts of Nagpur shall have exclusive jurisdiction in all the matter arising under and on account of this expression of interest.
- viii. At any time, prior to the last date of submission, Mahagenco may for any reason; whatsoever modify the EoI documents by amendment, which will be binding on all the agencies. Such amendment will be posted on Mahagenco website for all prospective agencies.
- ix. Mahagenco may at its discretion, extend the date for submission of application, if necessary.
- x. Applications which do not fulfill any of the above conditions or incomplete are liable for rejection.
- xi. Submission of an application by an agency implies that they have read all the above instructions and conditions of EoI and has made themselves aware of the terms and conditions for selection.
- xii. Application once submitted shall not be allowed to be withdrawn at any stage under any reason whatsoever.
- xiii. The agency shall abide themselves and fulfill all obligations in accordance with the law in force in India. In case during process of selection or during the contract period at any stage it is observed / found that any document furnished by the agency is forged / fabricated / false, then in addition to the action being taken in accordance with the provisions of law and the selection will be cancelled and the action will be taken suitably.
- xiv. MoU or Contract Agreement - as per Stamp Duty Act and cost of which shall be borne by the selected agency.
