For Group-B (20% SSI)

○ **B1: Qualifying requirement**

1. Nature of Business: Bidder should be ash product manufacturer (i.e. manufacturer of bricks, sheets, blocks, tiles, construction products, wall panels, cement sheets etc.) with SSI/ DIC / Udyam registration certificate.
2. Bidder should produce relevant license for their business (i.e consent to operate) from Pollution Control Board of respective areas. Industries falling under White category shall be exempted from this condition only after producing the acknowledgement of self-declaration submitted to the MPCB thereby confirming to be in white category.
3. Bidders manufacturing unit should be located within 300 KM radius of respective TPS.
4. Undertaking regarding purpose of use of POND ash.
5. Map showing the distance of manufacturing unit/plant of applicant from TPS.
6. If bidder is red brick manufacturer, then valid NA certificate for the Business issued by appropriate Government authority (Respective District).
7. GST Certificate of Business, Aadhar card of owner.
8. DIC Certificate or Udyog Adhar or Udyam registration certificate or Permission from relevant government office for Business.
9. NOC from Gram panchayat/ Municipality/ Municipal Corporation.
10. All vehicles shall have valid RTO registration and documents.
11. Money Receipt for EMD paid should be submitted along with documents submission , issued from Bhusawal TPS account section.
12. Any bidder/ agency already lifting pond ash under the Group-I and Group-III quota will not be entitled for participation in group-II. (See Annexure A for Group I, II and III definition)
13. The bidders who are presently lifting Fly Ash/POND Ash from Bhusawal TPS must clear their dues pending at Bhusawal TPS. If due found in scrutiny, the bidder will be disqualified.

Note: All documents should be original scan documents and quality OR scanning should be good and readable , otherwise not consider for bid.

○ **B2: Scope of Work**

1. Deployment of one JCB/Pock lain machines (owned/hired), machines/vehicles (owned/hired) shall have valid RTO registration.
2. Scientific excavation of pond ash from ash so as to avoid formation of water bodies in bund.
3. Leading of trucks/bulkers/vehicles with pond ash along with proper tarpaulin as to avoid spillage of pond ash on road.
4. Assistance in proper movement of vehicles (Bulkers, trucks, tractors etc) in and out of the ash bund of TPS.
5. Compliance of all pollution norms as prescribed by MPCB/CPCH/RTO etc as far as loading and transportation of pond ash is concerned. If any damages happens to MAHAGENCO properties, agency shall be held wholly responsible for the same and damages will be recovered from the agency.
6. Weekly cleaning of spilled ash on ash bund approach roads.
7. Maintaining record of the pond ash lifting vehicles on daily basis with details such as:
 - Name of agency
 - Vehicle/truck No
 - Capacity of vehicle/truck/bulker (MT)
 - Pond ash lifted quantity (MT)
 - Payment mode: cash/online etc.
8. Submission of pond ash lifting record containing all details mentioned at Sr.No.7 to TPS on daily basis
9. To sprinkle water on approach roads and in ash bund as per the instructions received from TPS officials
10. Prevention of excavation of pond ash by unauthorized agencies/persons.
11. Developing Ash bund surrounding area by means of Tree plantation, gardening etc
12. All qualifying bidders who matches the rate of H1 bidder shall be allotted the proportionate of their bidding quantity.
13. Maintenance and repair of roads shall be in the scope of agency after the placement of order.

○ **B3: TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

1. Contract Period: One Year
2. EMD: Rs. 10,000 /-
3. Security Deposit: - 5 % of the annual order value limited to Rs. 1 Lakh
4. Penalty: If any agency fails to lift 80% of allotted quantity of pond ash, Penalty for Short Lifting at rate of Rs. 10/MT for non-lifted quantity to be calculated quarterly.
5. Agency shall have to dispose of 50% of monthly allotted quantity given by TPS consecutively for the period of three months, failing which his order will be terminated.

○ **B4: Scope of Work**

Allocation Mechanism:

In continuation to the E-Auction Notice for 20% POND ASH Auction at Bhusawal TPS, following additional conditions are proposed to be incorporated for smooth auction process:

Auction Estimated Qty= 1.92 lakhs MT

TERMS & CONDITIONS – e-AUCTION OF POND ASH FOR 20% SSI QUOTA

1. Applicability

These terms and conditions shall be applicable for e-auction of POND Ash conducted by Group-A Thermal Power Stations of MAHAGENCO under State Ash Policy-2025, as approved by the Competent Authority .

2. Auction & Allocation Principle

Allocation shall be carried out round-wise, strictly based on bidder ranking (H1, H2,H3...)

In each round, mandatory acceptance of 25% of auctioned quantity at the applicable round rate is required to arrive at the final rate.

The remaining 75% quantity shall be allocated proportionately among eligible bidders who agree to match the arrived rate.

A round shall be treated as successful only if at least one bidder accepts the mandatory 25% quantity at that round rate.

3.Round-I (H1 Rate Round)

After auction closure, the highest quoted bidder shall be designated as H1.

H1 shall be mandatorily offered 25% quantity at H1 rate.

Example

case-1:

If H1 accepts 25% quantity

H1 rate becomes the final arrived rate.

Balance 75% quantity allotted proportionately to bidders matching H1 rate.

If H1 does not accept, but any lower bidder (H2 / H3 ...) accepts 25% at H1 rate

Such bidder becomes effective H1.

H1 rate remains final.

Allocation is done accordingly.

Case-2

If no bidder accepts 25% at H1 rate

H1 rate is scrapped.

Auction proceeds to Round-II.

4. Round-II and Subsequent Rounds

The next highest quoted rate (H2, then H3, etc.) shall become the round rate.

Same process of mandatory 25% acceptance and 75% proportional allocation shall apply.

Rounds shall continue sequentially until:

A bidder accepts 25% quantity, or
Auction reaches logical closure.

5. Matching with Successful Lower Bidder

Higher-ranked bidders (H1 / H2 / H3 ...) who initially did not accept 25% quantity are allowed to match the rate of the successful lower bidder who accepted the mandatory 25% quantity.

Upon matching, such bidders shall be considered for proportionate allocation from the balance 75% quantity.

Failure to match the successful bidder's rate shall attract penal action as specified below.

6. Penal Provisions: -

In case a bidder fails to comply with mandatory conditions:

- a) Forfeiture of EMD.
- b) Immediate disqualification from the ongoing auction.
- c) Cancellation of existing ash sale orders, if any.
- d) Debarment / blacklisting for a period of 03 years from participation in MAHAGENCO ash auctions.
- e) Penal action shall apply only to the defaulting bidder; other bidders shall not be affected.

7. General Conditions: -

Allocation and lifting shall be subject to:

- a) Availability of POND Ash,
- b) Plant operational constraints,
- c) Environmental and safety norms.
- d) MAHAGENCO reserves the right to modify, postpone, cancel or annul the auction without assigning any reason.
- e) Decision of Competent Authority / MAHAGENCO shall be final and binding in all matters related to auction and allocation.
- f) The bidder hereby declares on stamp paper Rs500/- with two witness sign that all documents submitted are true and correct, and in case any document is found false, forged, or misleading at any stage, MSPGCL shall be free to take action including cancellation of allotment, forfeiture of EMD/security deposit, imposition of penalty, and any other action as per MSPGCL rules, which the bidder agrees to bear.

8. Cancellation & Re-allocation:

In case of cancellation of any allotment due to non-compliance, the quantity shall be re-

allocated to eligible bidders as per auction ranking and proportionate quantity.

9. Regarding eAuction sole decision of Chief Engineer (O&M), BTPS shall be final.

10. MSPGCL may alter the Qualifying Requirement / terms and Conditions/ Allocation Mechanism at any time. **MSPGCL have right to cancel the Auction at any time.**

11. Ash will be issued on Subject to Availability basis.

12 MSPGCL reserves the right to make amendment /corrigendum or postpone e-auction wholly or partially without assigning reason thereof.
